All members of the 2009 Executive and Directors were re-elected at the April AGM.

Well, with Kiewit gone work has progressed on landscaping the archery and trap range area. A new archery course is planned in conjunction with two trap ranges on the rehabilitated Kiewit site.

Ditching remains to be done in order to direct water away from the trap and archery area and the front of the rifle range. Our neighbour, Sandy Biln has and continues to be most co-operative in is addressing joint issues! The new access to our club is contingent on first completing ditching. Our new club sign will then be installed.

Re-construction of the indoor range butt is underway while new rifle range distance markers have been installed. Work is about to strsat on the new outdoor handgun range. Club clean up has begun with one work party pileing woody material for burning and a container from Trident is on site to get rid of old metal objects. Work parties are now scheduled for the 2nd. and 4th. Saturday of each month, members are reminded that contributing a few hours each year is part of the membership. Without work parties the club would have to hire help to do various tasks and that would likely see fees going up again.

Policing agencies are continuing to rent our facilities while dog training course are again scheduled through the summer on Tuesday evenings. Don Walzak continues to provide CORE and Firearm courses on request.

Archery and biathlon sections are active with more and more young participants. Boy Scouts have used the indoor range with more use pending. The issue of water fowl hunting in the estuary is again under negotiation between the Distract of Squamish and Ministry of Environment – looks promising.
